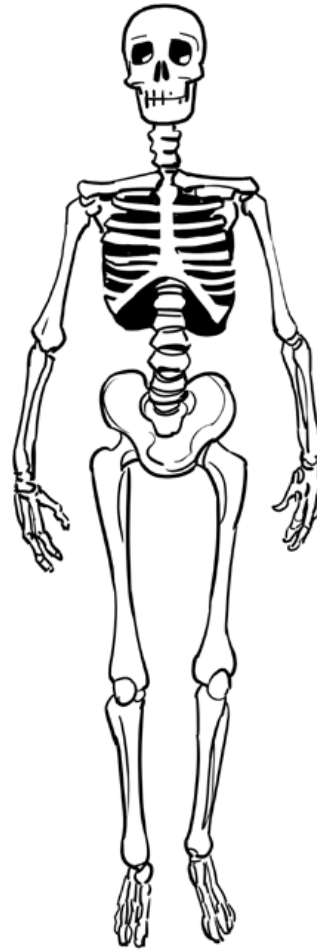
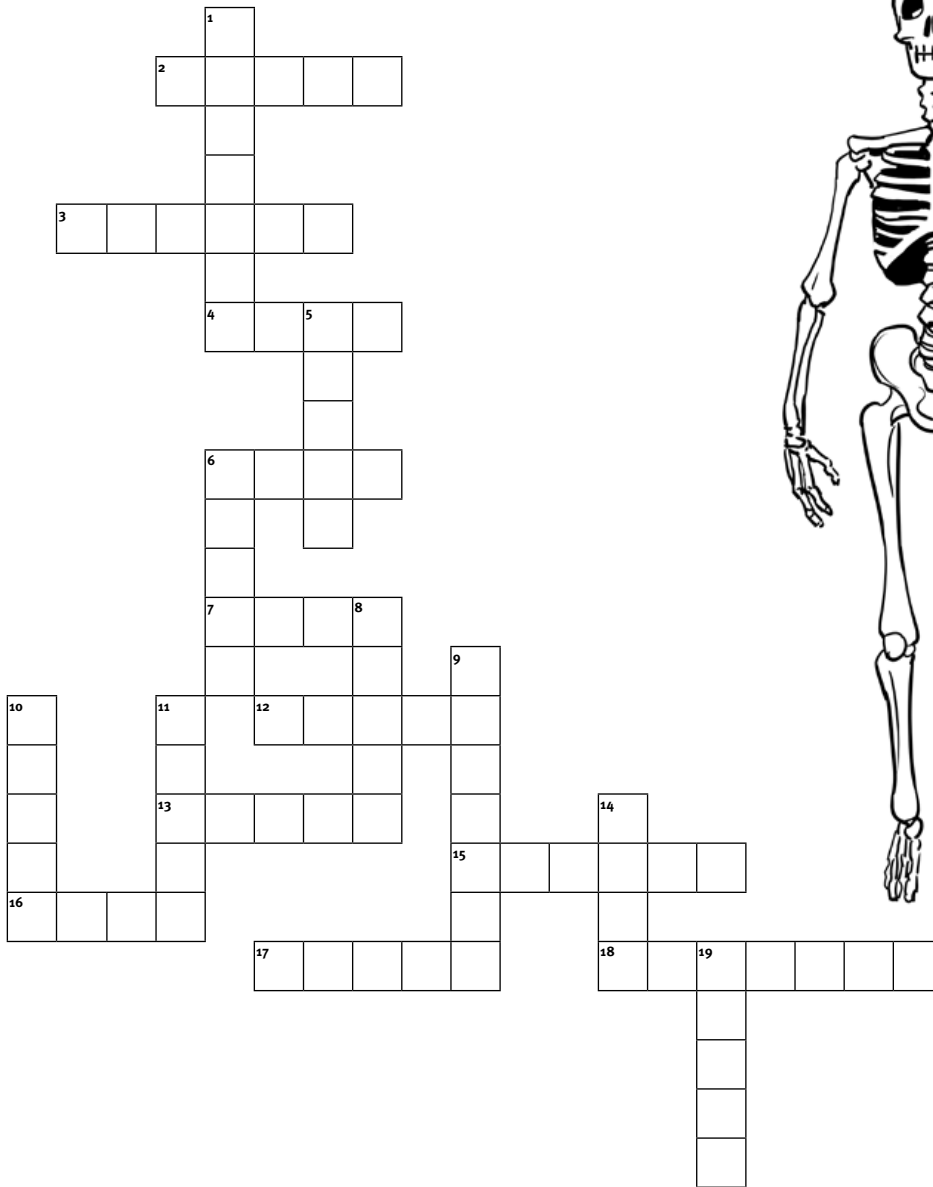


Use the clues below to complete the crossword.



Across

- 2 organs in the chest for breathing
- 3 this covers the eye when we blink
- 4 bottom part of the foot
- 6 back part of the foot
- 7 there are 24 of these bones in the chest
- 12 part of the body just above the hips

- 15 tube carrying blood from the heart
- 16 this covers the body
- 17 part of the leg above the knee

Aims To review parts of the body vocabulary

Time 10 minutes

Materials 1 handout for each student

- Give each student a copy of the handout and look at the first clue (2 Across) as a class. Elicit the answer *lungs* and tell students to write this in the appropriate place in the crossword grid.
- Allow students time to complete the rest of the puzzle. Check answers as a class, ensuring that students have spelled the words correctly and that they can pronounce them accurately.
